DRIVING TIPS - MALIHOM HILLTOP


If you are planning to drive to Hilltop of Malihom, here are some tips for you.

1. TRAFFIC LIGHT

The road up is a narrow **single lane** road. In order to avoid an oncoming car, you need to **activate** the traffic light at the foothill before you ascend. This is to inform vehicles at top that you are coming up.


If you see the traffic light flashing before you ascend, that means a vehicle is driving down. **Wait** for the vehicle to pass you before you proceed.

When you reach the top, deactivate the traffic light.



2. STEEP BENDS

The steepest part of Malihom is just after the traffic light on the first bend. You need to accelerate as you approach the bend, but maintain a safe speed. Make sure you are at the wider angle when taking a turn. See fig 2








3. SPEED LIMIT

Observe the speed limit (20km per hour). DO NOT go above that limit.

4. DRIVING DOWNHILL

Use lowgear when driving downhill



5. HANDBRAKES

If you're planning to stop and look at the view, please use your handbrakes.
